Highlights of the Tenth Regular Meeting of the *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est (CSDNE)*

North Bay, July 1st 2008 – *The Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l'Ontario (CSDNE)* held its tenth and last meeting of the school year on June 20 and 21, 2008, in North Bay.

During that meeting, the Board adopted a balanced budget for 2008/2009 set at \$31 151 756. This budget allows the Board to maintain its current services and programs as well as add new staff to ensure the academic success of its students.

The Board approved the leasing of new administrative offices in Timmins, at 111 Wilson Street. Eight CSDNE employees will work from those premises. The Board will also study the possibility of moving its main office to the former *École Héritage*, on Lakeshore Drive, North Bay. Finally, the Board approved the acquisition of a portable building to lodge the newly created daycare center at *École publique Héritage*, in North Bay. This new daycare facility will open in time for the next school year.

Lastly, the Board approved the appointment of Madame April Roserberger as principal of *École publique Héritage*, North Bay, as well as the appointment of Madame Chantal MacIvor as director of the Programme axé sur la réussite des élèves (PARÉ). Both will assume their new positions on August 5, 2008.
