North Bay, November 19, 2007 – The Board is proud to announce that five of its students have received a “Queen Elizabeth II Aiming for the Top” Scholarship.

The “Queen Elizabeth II Aiming for the Top” Scholarship is an Ontario government program designed to reward secondary school students who graduate with top marks and plan to continue their studies at an approved Ontario postsecondary institution. Students who maintain an average of at least 80% in their postsecondary studies can receive a maximum scholarship of \$3,500 a year, for a maximum of four years.
