



Official Opening: CANO Sturgeon Falls

Sturgeon Falls, November 7th, 2012 – The *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l'Ontario* (CSPNE) was proud to officially launch programs and services at the *Centre d'apprentissage du Nord-Est de l'Ontario* (CANO), an alternative learning centre in West Nipissing during a ceremony held this morning at its location on King Street in Sturgeon Falls.

CANO meets the existing needs of the West Nipissing region. The centre's objective is to fulfill the needs of all Francophone students, by offering a wide range of programs and activities to students for whom completing their High School Diploma in a traditional learning environment is a challenge and limits their opportunities at succeeding.

In fact, CANO offers the possibility to learn on a flexible schedule and on a self-paced learning agreement, in order to respect the student commitment, capabilities and goodwill. A CO-OP program allows the learner to work, receive an income and earn credits toward a diploma.

The concept of the alternative learning centre, located in Sturgeon Falls, is inspired by the success stories experienced since the opening of similar centres in Timmins and North Bay. CANO also offers services and programs in Kapuskasing and Cochrane. Students can register at any time during the school year.

This project was made possible through a partnership between the CSPNE and the Centre de formation du Nipissing. Learning services have been available since June 1, 2012.
