Northeastern Ontario, October 4, 2010 – The *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l'Ontario* (CSPNE) is proud to announce that four of its students have received a Queen Elizabeth II Aiming for the Top Scholarship from the Province of Ontario. The Queen Elizabeth II Aiming for the Top Scholarships is a Government of Ontario program designed to recognize students who received their High School Diploma with high marks and who apply to attend a recognized postsecondary educational institution in Ontario. Students who maintain an overall average of 80 % during their postsecondary studies can receive a maximum of \$3500 per year for up to four years.
