North-eastern Ontario, October 8th, 2009 – The *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l’Ontario* is proud to announce that three of its students have received a “Queen Elizabeth II Aiming for the Top” tuition scholarship.

This scholarship is a government of Ontario program designed to reward secondary school students who graduated with top marks and who plan to continue their studies at an approved Ontario postsecondary institution. Students who maintain an average of at least 80% in their postsecondary studies can receive a maximum tuition scholarship of \$3,500 per year, for a maximum of four years.
