Having worked in field of education for 35 years, Mrs. Charrette has continued to play a role in this area on a provincial level since 2004 as an Education Officer at the Ministry of Education. Mrs. Charrette had previously worked at Conseil scolaire catholique du Nouvel-Ontario as a teacher and school principal. Throughout her career, she has held various positions which called upon her strong leadership and keen organizational skills. Thanks to her determination, convictions, expertise and human values, she is certainly the perfect person to assume the position of Superintendent of Education at CSPNE.

Her work experience and vision in education are essential assets sought by CSPNE when selecting a superintendent who can meet the needs and requirements of the school board.
