



Report Card Sessions in the Schools of *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l'Ontario* (CSPNE)

Northeastern Ontario, February 7, 2011 - The *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l'Ontario* (CSPNE) invites parents of Elementary and Junior Level students (Grades 7 and 8) to attend a Report Card session during the week of February 7, 2011. For the first time in Ontario, parents will receive a Report Card that covers five months of learning. Parents should consider asking their child to participate in the Report Card review with the teacher.

These sessions are meant to be an official meeting between parents and teachers. The CSPNE strongly believes that clear and timely communications between teachers, parents and students concerning the student's learning performance will encourage students to set their own goals, help parents facilitate their child's learning at home, and also allow teachers to devise effective teaching plans.
