

Student Registrations at *École élémentaire publique de Hearst*



Northeastern Ontario, February 11, 2011 – Francophone parents from the Hearst region will be able to register their children at *École élémentaire publique de Hearst* as early as March 1st, 2011. This registration event will take place on Tuesday, March 1st, from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and will include a complimentary lunch. Parents who cannot attend this registration session will be able to meet with a resource person who will be at the new school (75, 9^e rue, Hearst) Wednesdays and Fridays from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., starting on March 21st when classes resume following the March Break.
