New Appointments at CSPNE

North Bay, June 20, 2017 – *Conseil scolaire public du Nord-Est de l'Ontario* (CSPNE) is pleased to announce two new appointments to its team: a Vice-Principal for École publique Odysée and a Student Services Director for Junior Kindergarten to Grade 6.

Mr. Raymond Ouellette will be the new Vice-Principal at École publique Odysée in North Bay. Mr. Ouellette has been acting Vice-Principal since last August and has accepted to continue in this position on a permanent basis effective August 1, 2017. He will be joining forces with Mrs. Ashli Lewis who was appointed school Principal a few weeks ago.

Mr. Ouellette has been with CSPNE for over 20 years and is actively involved in *Village du public* in North Bay. He is the ideal candidate to fulfill the duties and responsibilities of Vice-Principal thanks to his teaching experience at École publique Héritage and, as of 2005, at Odysée.

CSPNE has also approved the appointment of Mrs. Pauline Plutino as Student Services Director (Junior Kindergarten to Grade 6) at CSPNE. She will be replacing Mrs. Angelle Martel-Davies who, as of August 1, will be assuming the duties of Principal at École publique Héritage in North Bay.

From the beginning of her teaching career, Mrs. Plutino has contributed significantly to the field of education. Throughout the years as a classroom teacher, Special Education consultant, Vice-Principal at École publique Héritage (September 2012 – June 2015) and Educational Leader at Centre franco-ontarien de ressources pédagogiques (CFORP) since September 2015, she has acquired a wealth of knowledge and keen leadership skills that will serve her well in her new position.

CSPNE is confident that Mrs. Plutino and Mr. Ouellette will be up to the challenge of their new duties and will play a key role in student development and success.
