RE: École publique Passeport Jeunesse (elementary) Outbreak Declared Over

Please be advised that the outbreak at École publique Passeport Jeunesse (elementary) has been declared over. All cases and contacts have been resolved with no further evidence of transmission as it relates to the school.

As with anyone in our community, it is essential that all COVID-19 public health measures continue to be followed to protect yourself and those around you:

- Screen each morning by completing the online self-assessment tool: <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/school-screening/>.
- If you have symptoms call your local assessment centre to book a COVID-19 test.
- Stay home and isolate if you have any symptoms.
- Washing your hands often with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Practice cough and sneeze etiquette.
- Wear a mask in indoor public spaces.
- Maintain physical distance of at least 2 metres (6 feet).
- While outdoors, wear a mask when a minimum physical distance of 2 metres (6 feet) cannot be maintained with anyone outside your household.

In addition, if there are staff or children currently in isolation, as a result of a community exposure and not a school related exposure, they must remain in isolation and continue to follow public health guidance until released from isolation by public health.
